Though the pandemic has made the last two years a logistical challenge, our dedication to doing all that we can to support our libraries never wavers. Honoring Our History & Looking Towards the Future

On April 17, 2021, DCPLA hosted its first-ever online event, "DCPLA: 10 Years Strong." Designed to celebrate DCPLA's past, present, and future, the event featured video testimonials about the organization's positive impact from community leaders such as Daly City Mayor Juslyn Manalo, Colma Mayor Diana Colvin, City Manager Shawnna Maltbie, and San Mateo County Supervisor David Canepa. It also included a video chronicling DCPLA's founding and 10 years of service to our community,

created by Equivalent Exchange
Publishing, and a silent auction
with items like a 2-night stay at the
Silverado Resort and Spa in Napa
City and a Honey Bear by funch.
The highlight of the event was the
commencement ceremony for the Daly
City Youth Poet Laureate, the first in
San Mateo County.

"We are incredibly proud of our many accomplishments in the past ten years, and are excited to start a new chapter in our legacy with the launch of the Daly City Youth Poet Laureate program," said Victoria Magbilang, DCPLA's Executive Director.

DCPLA Names the First Youth Poet Laureate in San Mateo County

Oceana High School student
Madeleine Hur was named Daly City's
first Youth Poet Laureate during
our online event, "DCPLA: 10 Years
Strong." Madeleine was chosen
by the judges from among the 10
finalists because of her impressive
body of community activism and her
spellbinding creative writing.

During her term as DCYPL, Madeleine proved herself a worthy recipient of the title and the \$5,000 stipend, generously granted to DCPLA by Philanthropic Ventures Foundation. She participated in numerous community events, including being a guest speaker at San Mateo Youth County Commission's 2021 NorCal


Youth Empowerment Conference, "Words that Heal," hosted by DCPLA; participating in the "Respect 24/7" conference in October hosted by the San Mateo County Office of Education, where she read her poem "Voices of Youth;" participating in "Love Our Youth," hosted by San Mateo County poets Megan Duffy Brown & Monica Korde; performing one of her original poems at the Bayshore Block Party hosted by Bayshore Elementary School; prerecording a reading for Make a Difference Day hosted by Daly City City Manager and Mayor with C.L.E.A.N.; being featured as one of 10 young poets around the world

in a showcase, "Freedom Across the Globe," hosted by Poetry Society and Urban Word; organizing youth volunteers for DCPLA's Used Book Sale event; and working with San Mateo County Poet Laureate Aileen Cassinetto on an online poetry workshop for the 2022-2023 DCYPL applicants.

For her accomplishments, Madeleine was honored by the City Council of the Town of Colma with a plaque of her poems displayed in Town Hall and by the City Council of Daly City, who invited her to perform at the City Government Reorganization in December.
